

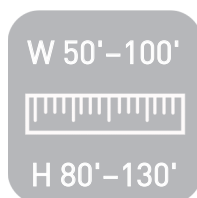

Black Cottonwood

Populus trichocarpa
Willow Family



W 50'–100'

H 80'–130'

- Great for windbreaks and shelterbelts
- Is a very fast-growing, large tree that is easy to establish and useful for shade
- Aggressive root systems are useful in restoration of riparian areas
- Smaller trees will often sprout from the roots of a mature tree
