Douglas Fir

Pseudotsuga menziesii
Pine Family



- Is an excellent tree for windbreaks, restoring eroded lands, watersheds, strip-mined areas, and for recreational areas
- Drought tolerant and adapted to a wide variety of soil textures; does best in well-drained soils
- Douglas fir is not a true fir (not a member of the genus *Abies*)
- An important timber tree, accounting for nearly 1/4 of total lumber produced in North America
