# Douglas Spirea

*Spiraea douglasii*  
Rose Family

- Useful in wetland and riparian restoration for slope stabilization
- Has tiny, fragrant pink flowers in dense, elongated clusters at the end of their spikes
- Flowers provide an important source of nectar for pollinators
- Hybridizes in the wild with White Spirea (*Spiraea betulifolia*)
