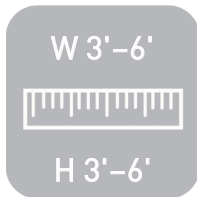

- Best used in naturalized settings as it spreads by suckers and rhizomes, forming dense thickets
- The hips, or fruit, can be used to make jams, jellies, teas, and syrups that are packed with Vitamin C
- Distinguished from other native roses by its large hooked bristles and 1/2" long hips
- Excellent selection for reclamation and restoration sites
