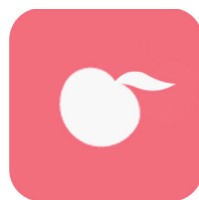
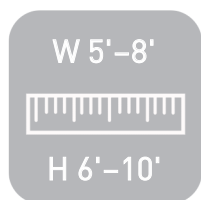




Red-osier Dogwood

Cornus sericea
Dogwood Family



- Has a thicket-forming habit, making it a great hedgerow option; has a fibrous root system that provides effective erosion control on banks and slopes
- Has red autumn foliage
- Deep-red stems create a pop of color during the snowy, gray months
- Prefers moist soils and often grows in riparian areas
- Does not tolerate dry soil
