Showy Aster

Eurybia conspicua

Sunflower/Aster Family

- Forms beautiful colonies due to its rhizomatous nature
- Large patches of this plant (without flowers) are very common in the understory of Douglas Fir and subalpine fir forests
- Abundant flowering occurs following a canopy disturbance such as a fire, or along roads and trails
- Leaves are triangular and toothed
