Blue-eyed Grass

- A small, unique, evergreen plant with grass-like leaves and attractive blue star-shaped flowers that bloom mid-spring to mid-summer
- A popular nectar and pollen plant for native bees and other beneficial insects
- Often found in moist meadows or on the edges of wetlands or stream banks
