Drummond Willow

Salix drummondiana
Willow Family

- Provides important streambank protection by effectively stabilizing soils
- Male & female flowers are produced on separate plants (dioecious)
- Underside of leaves have felt-like hairs
- Contains a chemical closely related to aspirin
- Important winter food for moose & beavers
