Grand Fir

Abies grandis
Pine Family



W 30'-50'
H 100'-200'

- Shade tolerant but less so than Hemlock and Cedar
- Has attractive pyramidal growth
- Recognized by long needles borne horizontally on opposite sides, appearing flattened; needles are silvery on the underside; new needles are distinctly lighter green
- Provides useful cover and nesting sites
- Grows well in riparian areas and disturbed sites
