# Idaho Fescue

*Festuca idahoensis*  
(syn. *Festuca ingrata*)

*Poaceae*



- Drought tolerant bunchgrass
- Well known for its distinctive blue-green or purplish leaves that provide beautiful texture in residential landscapes
- Great for planting in contemporary landscapes since it is clump forming
- Provides an extensive, deep root system, making it an excellent erosion control species
- Competes well with aggressive introduced grasses
