Koeleria macrantha

- A cool season bunchgrass
- An ideal species for use in prairie restoration due to its ability to recolonize severely dry or disturbed areas
- Flower cluster of numerous spikelets are large and stout relative to the size of plant
- Well-known members of this family include cereal grains such as wheat, corn, rice, and oats
