# Rubber Rabbitbrush

*Ericameria nauseosa*  
Sunflower/Aster Family

- Thrives in dry, hot locations as well as poor soil conditions
- Has attractive silver foliage with bright yellow flowers and feathery plume seed heads
- One of the last blooms in fall that often survives frosts
- Useful for soil stabilization and restoration of disturbed sites
- Used by Native Americans as a yellow dye, a medicinal tea, and for chewing gum
- "Rubber" refers to the rubber content in the sap
