- Great shrub for hedgerows and windbreaks
- Drought tolerant
- Thicket-forming due to its ability to sucker
- Nitrogen fixing
- Male and female flowers found on separate plants
- Performs well in dry to wet sites; tolerant of some flooding
- Provides cover and nesting sites for many birds
