Ticklegrass

Agrostis scabra
Poaceae



- Perennial bunchgrass
- Inflorescence is a wide open array of branches
- Flower clusters turn purple-green to tan
- Reproduces by seed and vegetatively by stolons
- Pioneer species that grows following a fire
- Effective in preventing soil erosion
- Grows in a wide range of habitat types
