# Yellow Monkeyflower

*Erythranthe guttata*  
Lopseed Family

- A self-seeding annual with a spreading habit
- Once pollinated, the two outer petals snap closed to prevent cross pollination
- Named because the flower is said to look like the face of a monkey
- Found in moist areas
